## ACCOMMODATIONS & EVENTS VENUES

Yukon offers a number of up-to-date hotels (3 and 3.5 star on Canada Select) with amenities to please discerning meeting goers: indoor exercise centres, wireless internet, in-room coffee makers, laundry facilities, gifts shops, lounges, and a broad range of in-house dining and conference facilities. Major hotels are a mere two or three blocks apart — so that making use of two or more facilities presents few problems for conference organizers.

In addition, for those seeking smaller, quieter venues, out-of-town facilities provide more limited meeting space but spectacular views. A number of convenient and high quality B&Bs offer a very special Yukon experience.

Museums (Whitehorse has several), the Arts Centre, Yukon College, the Yukon Convention Centre, St. Elias Convention Centre, and the Canada Games Centre are only a few of the alternate facilities that may be used for off-site events, receptions, and meetings both large and small.
